Strengthen the Church



Truth must start in the house of God.

Before we can influence the culture, we must first disciple the church.

The greatest defense against deception is a congregation that knows and loves Scripture.

Practical Ways to Strengthen the Church:

- Preach a clear biblical worldview on current issues – from identity to justice to freedom.
- Teach your congregation how to defend their faith graciously in everyday conversations.
- Create small groups focused on prayer and cultural discernment.
- Equip elders and ministry leaders with resources on faith and freedom.

When the church is grounded in truth, it becomes unshakable – even when the world shifts around it.



Speak Into the Public Square



Silence is not neutrality. It's surrender.

The Canadian church must rediscover its prophetic voice – not as an enemy of the state, but as a conscience for the nation.

Ways to Engage the Public Square:

- Encourage your church members to vote their values and stay informed.
- Build respectful relationships with local representatives and civic leaders.
- Write or co-sign letters that express biblical perspectives on policy.
- Host a community forum or prayer night addressing national issues through a biblical lens.

You don't need to be political to be influential – you just need to be faithful.

Your words carry weight. Use them to point your community back to the truth that sets people free.



Support and Mobilize



No pastor should stand alone.
